Supporting Young Parents Program

Eligibility to Supporting Young Parents Program

The program is specifically targeted at both pregnant youth and new parents aged between 16-25 who are either homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.



Access

Access is via MASP Homelessness intake and clients are allocated to the SYPP Young Parents Housing Worker via referral from the Housing Intake program.

Program Objectives

- To provide support to young parents which will enable them to maintain safe and stable accommodation.
- Increase young parents access to a range of resources/information related to their needs as young people and also their needs as parents including the needs of their children.
- Promote breastfeeding as the normal method of infant feeding for young parents and provide links to breastfeeding support services in the Sunraysia area.
- Support, promote and maintain social inclusion for young parents and building of young parents support networks.
- Advocacy for young parents on both an individual needs basis and as a group.
- Address access to services in rural areas
- Flexibility to respond to individual needs, (outreach, home visits and drop in etc)
