

RESIDENTS' RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

Residents must furnish, clean and maintain their own private room.

The residents' rooms are secure and private and entry is only by the resident's invitation or permission.

Residents sign a Residency Agreement which includes terms and conditions of residence and sets out rights and responsibilities for the resident and the owner.

Residents must also abide by House Rules centred on respect for other residents and the property.

All residents actively contribute and have a voice in matters relating to the day-to-day management of the house.



COST

The fortnightly rental fee is \$600 and covers household expenses including all meals, electricity, property maintenance, heating and cooling, rates and water usage.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Family and friends are welcome to visit with the resident between 10.00am – 9.00pm or by arrangement with Vidovic House.

No pets are allowed.

Supported Independent Living

ACCOMMODATION OVERVIEW

MASP's Supported Independent Living (SIL) property, Vidovic House, is funded by the NDIS to provide supports to people with disability to help them live as independently as possible.

Supported Independent Living is funded under Core Supports – Assistance with Daily Life - in the NDIS plan.

The NDIS does not fund the cost of rent, board, transport, and other day-to-day expenses such as food and activities.

The facility will accommodate up to six residents with mild physical and/or intellectual disabilities who would find it difficult to maintain their own independent accommodation without support.



The residents share the garden, undercover areas and the communal parts of the house and enjoy the mutual support and companionship that develops from living together.

The facility is close to Mildura Central ensuring residents are provided with a range of services in close proximity.

Each resident occupies their own room and shares bathroom, laundry, kitchen and lounge room facilities.



RESIDENT SUPPORT

Vidovic House is designed to help people stay independent and active in their community, whilst providing some day-to-day living support, social interaction and monitoring of health and well-being.

There are staff in the home 24/7 to support residents with household tasks and activities in groups and 1:1.

Residents also engage in a shared household task roster that includes:

- cleaning shared bathroom & own bed room
- planning and cooking meals (1:1 support) for the residents in the home
- cleaning shared living and kitchen area
